

YANBO ZHANG MD, Ph.D.

Dr. Zhang completed his medical education and Ph.D. degree in Peking University in China and received postdoctoral fellowships and residency training in psychiatry at the University of Saskatchewan Canada. He is a clinician-scientist and the Iver and Joyce Graham Indiana Small Professor in the College of Medicine at the University of Saskatchewan.

Dr. Zhang's research interests focus on the impacts of psychiatric medications and magnetic brain stimulations on white matter dysfunction in severe mental disorders diseases using animal models. He has published 35 articles in international journals, including Molecular Psychiatry, Schizophrenia Research, Glia, and Journal of Neurochemistry.

Clinically, Dr. Zhang Yanbo promotes integrated care for mental health condition with family doctors and provides consultation and education services for general practitioners. He is currently a psychiatrist at the Student Center of Saskatchewan University in Canada and is also involved in the formulation and management of mental health education programs.

He also serves as the secretary-treasurer of the Canadian Psychiatric Association (CPA), the national professional association of psychiatrists in Canada who develops treatment guidelines, mental health policies and continuing education for Canadian psychiatrists.
